Who we are...

- School for Little Children's Governing Board is comprised of 11 volunteers, including past and present parents, and/or individuals with a connection to School for Little Children.
- Currently, our Board includes a President, Vice-President, Treasurer, Secretary, Human Resources Chair, Development Committee Chair and two Parent Committee representatives as well as voting Members-at-Large. Non-voting members who sit on the board include School for Little Children's Director and Associate Director, as well as interested SLC parents who may serve as a board Associate.

What we do...

- The Governing Board of School for Little Children supports the vision and mission of our school. We are responsible for planning, resource allocation and decision making in all areas of operation of School for Little Children.
- Throughout the year, board members monitor and evaluate areas of our strategic plan -- primarily financial sustainability, community connections, professional development, curriculum enrichment and leadership and succession -- to maintain our high-quality teachers, preschool education and environment.



Governing Board Members – Responsibilities & Expectations

- Shall hold office for a two-year term, with the option to renew the term once
- Attend a mandatory Governing Board orientation meeting, prior to the beginning of the term
- Attend and participate in all monthly Governing Board meetings, missing no more than three meetings in a school year
- Be informed about SLC's vision, mission, core values and other priorities set forth in the strategic plan
- Be informed about SLC's programs and policies
- Provide guidance and support to the SLC Director with respect to the implementation of SLC's policies, procedures and strategic priorities
- Promote and attend SLC fundraisers and special events
- Serve on at least one additional Governing Board subcommittee (e.g., Development, Human Resources, Long term Planning, Nominating), and participate in all meetings of that committee
- Review agenda and supporting materials prior to Governing Board and committee meetings
- Assist the Governing Board in carrying out its fiduciary responsibilities, such as reviewing quarterly financial statements and participating in the budgeting process
- Comply with conflict of interest and confidentiality policies
- Make the Governing Board aware of any information or situation that may be of concern to the Governing Board and/or SLC
- Seek out and suggest possible nominees to the Governing Board who can make significant contributions to the work of the Board
- Be an ambassador for SLC in the community
- Make an annual contribution to SLC in an amount that is financially meaningful to you
